

Supply List Leather Rebacking

Required

- Students should bring to class five or six old leather bindings with loose boards and/or spines, or cracked joints. The books should be octavo size, and have intact sewing and stable leather. No large books such as folios, atlases, dictionaries, or encyclopedias. Remember that these books are intended for practice, and shouldn't have any real value.
- 1/4" flat brush to use with acrylics
- 1/2" flat brush
- straightedge
- plastic containers for holding glue and paste
- tweezers
- Caselli spatula (#3) sold in the NBSS store, and also available here:

- For lifting, each student will need a lifting knife. I recommend these:

- Each student should bring whatever he or she uses for paring leather: English paring knife and spokeshave; French paring knife; Scharf-fix and scalpel, etc. I can provide advice if needed.
